YOUR LOCAL NEIGHBOURHOOD team – consisting of PCSO Nic Unsworth, PC Robert Deacock, SGT Emma Storey-Barrett, and SGT Matt Clark are working closely with partner agencies and we are always ready to listen to any concerns about security and safety that the residents of St Leonards have.

As a team, we have been out in the community dealing with issues and reports that have been made to us and, where required, working with partner agencies. We are aware that, in the Exeter area, there are opportunists in our community who will take items where they feel there are no witnesses or CCTV to show them committing the offence. Please, where possible, take serial numbers, etc., as this will help us when we come across items at a property or on a person.

We have also been made aware of vehicles that have been damaged and some having had items placed under the tyres causing expense to the owner and disrupting their planned day. We ask that any residents that notice anybody acting suspiciously, such as paying attention to vehicles, etc., to contact police. St Leonards remains one of the safest communities in Exeter to be living.

Calls to police regarding concerns and issues are very important to us and some calls do not need a police unit to attend on every occasion, but please do not feel that we have not done anything regarding the call. We use information from these calls as intelligence, that can be used at a later date, i.e. drug warrants, etc.

Exeter neighbourhood policing team have been working with partner agencies in the community.
